## **Internet access**

*Eduroam is available on campus and in parts of downtown Lund. If you do not have Eduroam, you can connect to the internet using the LU Guest network:*

1. Select "LU Guest" in available networks on your device.
2. Start a web browser
3. You should arrive at a page asking for SMS-registration or e-mail registration. If it does not automatically show, try connecting to any webpage and it should appear.
4. Chose to register via SMS or by e-mail.
5. Write your name and phone number or email address. Accept terms and conditions and select "Register".
6. Enter the code you receive via SMS or e-mail depending on method of registration, and select "Log In".
